EXT. MENDON TWIN DRIVE IN TICKET BOOTH - DAY

DAVE

First we want to thank all the families and individuals who are practicing social distancing and self-quarantine.

MIKE

We're sure you could use a small break from your houses.

DAN

Why don't you move your quarantine to your car and come catch a movie.

EXT. MENDON TWIN DRIVE IN LOT/SCREEN ONE - DUSK

Dave walks down the row of cars, massive screen behind him silently playing previews.

DAVE

We will be taking all the precautions to keep our customers as safe as possible. We have numbered and spaced each car spot at least twelve feet from the nearest vehicle.

EXT. DRIVE IN SNACK BAR - DUSK
